## SteelMint launches Thailand Scrap Import Assessment

Thailand is an emerging imported scrap destination in South-East Asia. The country's scrap demand is around 4-4.5 mn t scrap annually. While the country source the same from domestically around 3 mn t and around 1-1.5 mn t imported scrap.

Thailand imported nearly 1.57 mn t ferrous scrap in CY'21 against 1.3 mn t in CY'20. Out of total scrap imported in CY'21, volumes from US stood at 0.2 mn t, Australia at 0.19 mn t and Panama at 0.12 mn t. After undertaking market feedback, SteelMint has planned to launch the following price assessment.
