

## Pricing Notice: BigMint enhances coal vessel freight coverage with new Indonesia-India assessment

We are pleased to announce that BigMint is expanding its current portfolio of coal vessel freight assessments. In addition to our existing assessments of Australia-India & South Africa-India, we will now be including freight assessment for Indonesia-India. This expansion is part of our ongoing commitment to providing comprehensive and accurate market insights, catering to the diverse needs of our stakeholders in the coal & energy industry. India's coal imports from Indonesia was around 106.2 million tonnes (mnt) in CY23 as per BigMint data.

Out of this, coking coal and non coking coal imports were recorded around 2.6 mnt and 102.9 mnt respectively. Key unloading ports in India were - Mundra, Navlakhi and Krishnapatnam. Additionally, coal import from Indonesia to Navlakhi port, India stood at 8.7 mnt in CY23. Notably, from East Kalimantan region, Samarinda port recorded highest exports to India at 84.45 mnt in CY23.
